Dress Code

Proper dress habits are prerequisites for good work habits. We take pride in the appearance of our students. Their dress reflects the quality of the school, their conduct, and their schoolwork. Uniforms may be purchased at Educational Outfitters, Nashua NH or online at Lands' End. Please see below for purchasing specifics....

Girls:

- Plaid Jumper (it is recommended that girls wear "privacy shorts" under jumpers)
- Navy Pants
- Navy Skort (This will no longer be sold, may be worn if still owned)
- Blouse Light blue or white knit polo shirt with school logo on collar long or short sleeve; Light blue or white short or long sleeve Peter Pan blouse with school logo on collar
- Sweater Royal blue school sweater with school logo
- Gym Uniform Royal blue T-shirt, sweatshirt, sweatpants, and shorts with school logo. Sneakers must be worn on gym day. Jewelry of any kind is not permitted during physical education classes.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times

The items listed above in bold print are only available at Educational Outfitters

- Socks/Tights Plain navy blue or white knee length socks **or** tights may be worn; socks must cover the ankle at all times.
- White, navy blue or black leggings may be worn in the winter months only.
- Shoes It is impossible for us to stay current on the latest styles in footwear. Casual shoes that cover the foot with a low or moderate heel or sneakers are acceptable. All footwear must be properly laced and tied at all times and must stay securely on the foot. If storm boots are worn, students must bring shoes to wear in school. Boots, sandals, flip-flops, high heels, backless shoes, Uggs, and Crocs are not allowed.
- Jewelry/Make-up Jewelry should be kept simple and appropriate for school attire. Make up is never allowed, **including tinted lip balms**. Only clear lip balm may be used.

Bovs:

- Dress Pants Navy Blue
- Shirts Light blue or white knit polo shirt with school logo on collar long or short sleeve; **Light blue or white short or long sleeve dress shirt with school logo on collar**
- Sweater/Vest Royal blue school sweater/vest with school logo

- Gym Uniform Royal blue t-shirt, sweatshirt, sweatpants, and shorts with school logo. Sneakers must be worn on gym day. Jewelry of any kind is not permitted during physical education classes.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

The items listed above in bold print are only available at Educational Outfitters

- Socks Plain navy blue, white, or black. Socks must have a cuff that <u>covers the</u> <u>entire ankle</u>. Sports socks, logos or designs are not allowed.
- Shoes Casual shoes that cover the foot or sneakers are acceptable. All footwear must be properly laced and tied at all times and must stay securely on the foot. Crocs, boots, and flip-flops are not allowed. If storm boots are worn, the students must bring shoes to wear in school.
- Jewelry Jewelry should be kept simple and appropriate for school attire. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.

Mass and Special Occasion Attire

At the discretion of the Principal, students will be called upon on Mass days and special occasions to wear the following version of their school uniform:

Girl's options include:

- Jumper with a white uniform dress blouse (peter pan collar or oxford) and white knee socks
- Navy blue uniform pants with a white dress blouse and navy blue socks
- Black shoes with less than a one inch heel or black sneakers
- IJS sweater or vest optional

Boy's options include:

- Navy blue uniform pants with navy blue socks
- White uniform dress shirt (oxford or pointed collar)
- Black shoes or black sneakers
- IJS sweater or vest optional

No Uniform Day Dress Code

- Spaghetti straps are never allowed.
- Tee shirts/shirts or articles that display rock groups, violence, or any other logos that the administration finds objectionable to the standard of the school are not to be worn.
- Shorts and skirts should be at least fingertip length.
- Uggs are allowed on No Uniform Days.
- Head coverings cannot be worn in the building.
- Jewelry should be kept simple and appropriate for school attire. Makeup is not allowed during the school day.

Warm Weather Uniform for Girls/Boys:

During the warm weather months, students are allowed to wear navy twill shorts. Students must wear their regular uniforms if they do not wish to purchase the shorts. Students may also wear low-cut plain navy blue, white, or black socks. Socks must have a cuff that covers the entire ankle. Sports socks, logos or designs are not allowed.

Warm weather uniforms may be worn from the first day of school until October 31 then again from May 1 until the end of school.

Shorts may be purchased from Educational Outfitters or online at Lands' End

Other Guidelines:

- Multiple key chains are not allowed on the students' backpacks or lunch containers.
- Tattoos are not allowed.
- Tee shirts/shirts or articles that display rock groups, violence, or any other logos that the administration finds objectionable to the standard of the school are not to be worn, nor are they to be displayed on books, book covers, etc.
- Head coverings cannot be worn in the building. Including large bows, hats, scarves, etc.
- All uniforms must be in good condition, no holes, frayed edges, stains, etc.
- Shorts, skirts, and skorts should be fingertip length at minimum
- All undershirts must be solid white. It should not be visible underneath the uniform shirt.

Hairstyles: Extreme hairstyles are not allowed (shaved rows, railroad tracks, dyed, highlighted, bleached, etc.). Colored hairpieces are not allowed. Students should come to school with clean and neat hair at all times.

Violations: The following procedures will be used with anyone in violation of the school dress code:

First Offense: Student will receive a fair reminder from the homeroom teacher and an article of clothing from our "used" clothing inventory, to wear during the day. The student will also receive a written reminder from the teacher.

- **Second Offense**: A written notification will be sent by the school Principal to the parent/parents, and the student will be given an article of clothing from our "used" clothing inventory to wear during the day.
- Third Offense: Failure to comply with the dress code will result in disciplinary action to be given at the discretion of the Principal. May include but not limited to detention, exclusion from participation in the next out-of-uniform day.

Good Rule to Follow: If you think you shouldn't wear it, you shouldn't!
